Sacrament of Baptism

Parents who wish to have their children baptized must fill out a baptismal form to be submitted to the parish office. The baptism form is available on our parish website, at the parish office, or at the desk at the entrance to our worship space. We celebrate baptism during our Sunday Eucharists or anytime by agreement with the pastor.

Sacrament of Marriage

Couples planning to be married must contact the priest one year in advance. A marriage course is required. The wedding will either be held at Merciful Redeemer Church or at St. Peter's Mission Church.

Funerals

Losing someone through death is very difficult for anyone. To help you plan the funeral, please contact the parish office. We will hold the Liturgy at Merciful Redeemer or at St. Peter's Mission Church.

Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ.

A good number of our parishioners do not realize that the Tabernacle where we keep the Eucharist is located in the chapel across from where we gather for Holy Mass. The chapel is open for anyone who wish to spend some moments of prayer before or after the Mass. As your pastor, I realized that it is difficult to concentrate when there is so much activity before or after our Eucharistic celebration around our gathering space - choir practice, altar preparation, conversations in the hallway, to name a few. I invite you to go instead into the chapel to spend that few moments of prayer before the abiding presence of our Eucharistic King.

Until we have our own church, we will have to make the necessary adjustment. I ask for the cooperation of the members of our various choirs to provide at least five (5) minutes of silence before the Holy Mass begins and for the Arts and Environment Committee to remove the altar fifteen (15) or twenty (20) minutes after the 12:30 PM Holy Mass is over. Sometimes in our desire to wrap everything up quickly we forget that someone is still praying.

Divorced people are not "outside" the Church

A Brazilian family raised the issue of divorced couples who have remarried and cannot avail themselves of the Sacraments. Benedict XVI affirmed that "this is one of the the great causes of suffering for the Church today, and we do not have simple solutions. ... Naturally, one very important factor is prevention. This means ensuring that, from the beginning, the act of falling love is transformed in a more profound and mature decision. Another factor is that of accompanying people during marriage, to ensure that families are never alone but find authentic company on their journey. We must tell people in this situation that the Church loves them, but they must see and feel this love". Parishes and other Catholic communities "must do everything possible so that such people feel loved and accepted, that they are not 'outsiders' even if they cannot receive absolution and the Eucharist. They must see that they too live fully within the Church. ... The Eucharist is real and shared if people truly enter into communion with the Body of Christ. Even without the 'corporeal' assumption of the Sacrament, we can be spiritually united to Christ". It is important for divorced couples "to have the chance to live a life of faith, ... to see that their suffering is a gift for the Church, because they also help others to defend the stability of love, of Marriage; ... theirs is a suffering in the community of the Church for the great values of our faith".
