From the Pastor

My dear friends, I would like to initiate a process of consultation with everyone in the parish as we look forward to having our new church, possibly at the beginning of Advent. We will review together our schedule of Masses, existing programs and ministries; all aspects of our parish life. In the weeks ahead, a box will be prepared with some specific topic of concern for you to comment and make suggestions. They will be collated and presented to the community for consideration and discernment. Your input will be most appreciated. We all dream of having a vibrant catholic community "that will witness and proclaim, celebrate and share the Greatest Love of Jesus Christ Crucified and Mary, Mother of Charity at the foot of the Cross."

We have been so blessed to connect our story with the Irish Catholic community that came to pioneer the villages of Churchill Meadows and Lisgar two hundred years ago. The area became known as "The Catholic Swamp". Life was very difficult, but their faith sustained them as evidenced by the small Church of St. Peter's on the Ninth Line. Many of you have grown attached to the small church and it will be difficult to let it go. God knows how much I have prayed and lobbied to have this church under our care permanently, but it is not meant to be. After consulting with our bishops, we will be returning the church to the Hamilton Diocese and to Holy Rosary Parish in Milton at the end of November. The church will most likely be used by an Eastern rite Catholic community, possibly the Maronites or the Romanian Byzantine. I personally think that the presence of the Eastern rite church in our area will help us learn to breathe with two lungs as St. John Paul II has encouraged us.

Update on the construction of the church



The workers have started to lay the brick work and the duct work is being installed underneath the nave. They have also started to work on the parking lot. Please continue to pray for the safety of all our construction workers.

I am grateful to all the families that have contributed towards the purchase of the pews.

We still need about 19 pews. Also, thank you to those who have contributed to the restoration of the Tabernacle. Boyer and I have delivered it to Bramante Studio last Tuesday. It will take them five to six months to work on it.

I have also received a quote of \$110,000 + HST for our Sound and Video system. This is an important component to be installed, but I have to be honest...we are short of funds. We have the musical extravaganza that we hope will raise some money, but even if we sell a hundred tickets it will probably not be enough to cover for the HST. Please consider making a contribution towards the purchase of this system.
