#### **Executive Summary of the Feasibility Study**

#### Overview

St Josephine Bakhita is viewed as a growing, friendly, welcoming and diverse community that is enthusiastic about having a church building of their own. The parish community requires a church building complete with a new chapel, hall, offices and meeting rooms.

Parishioners are generally knowledgeable about financial needs in connection with the plans for the new church and other buildings.

#### **The Case**

Participants are largely aware or somewhat aware, ninety-five percent (95%), of St Josephine Bakhita Parish's financial needs and are supportive, ninety-five percent (95%), of the plans outlined in the Preliminary Case for Support. The Case is highly supported, however, more details regarding certain aspects of the plans are recommended.

Many respondents had questions regarding certain aspects of the construction plans. The most frequently stated concern was the adequacy of parking spaces. All of the elements outlined in the Case were of high priority to the majority of parishioners with the exception of the Archdiocesan share of the Family of Faith campaign which was moderately supported.

In general, the plans are enthusiastically endorsed by the interviewees. However, many questions about the detailed construction costs and interior costs are required.

#### Leadership and Volunteerism

While many respondents were reluctant to name parishioners, a few recommended capable individuals who could lead a campaign. In all, eighteen (18) parishioners were identified by respondents as people capable of leading a campaign. Many people would also consider volunteering for a committee or visiting fellow parishioners in a fundraising situation. All indicators in this area are strong and St Josephine Bakhita would have the leadership required to embark on a campaign.

Goal Attainability and Financial Support

Of the 62 respondents interviewed, fifty-six (56) agreed to support the campaign financially, two might contribute financially, two would not and two did not answer. Of the fifty-six (56) respondents participating financially there was a total of \$338,501 on the low end for an average of \$5,737. This is a moderate average gift size for campaigning.

Participants were cautiously optimistic about the attainability of the initial goal. Many had suggestions about fundraising activities and sponsorship ideas to support the campaign.

#### Other

Participants support a campaign in the parish with seventy-four percent (74%) stating that the campaign is high priority for them. The Family of Faith Campaign is seen as a good vehicle for pursuing the financial support needed.

There is opportunity within the parish for bequest notification and donations. A program of information and bequest identifications would greatly benefit the parish.

#### Recommendations

Overall, a campaign at St Josephine Bakhita parish has broad support and enthusiastic approval of parishioners. Supporters are eager to commence the construction of their new church and other buildings. It is our recommendation that the parish can raise between \$1.5M and \$2.0M for the construction of the new church, hall, offices and meeting rooms including parking and landscaping.

It is also important to provide the some critical additional information regarding certain aspects of the plans prior to actual fundraising.

The parish may address the above additional information while commencing with the planning of a fundraising campaign immediately.

Once the parish has discerned this report, a full communication to parishioners is recommended.

Thanks to God's compassion given to us in Jesus, "many families demonstrate in their actions that death does not have the last word. Every time that a bereaved family - even terribly - finds the strength to keep the faith and love that unite us to those whom we love, it prevents death from claiming everything. The darkness of death must be faced with more intense love. In the light of the Resurrection of the Lord, Who never abandons any of those whom the Father has entrusted to Him, we can remove the 'sting' from death, as the apostle Paul said; we can prevent it from poisoning life, from spoiling our affections, from making us fall into the darkest emptiness. In this faith, we are able to console each other, knowing that the Lord has defeated death once and for all. Our dear ones have not disappeared into the darkness of nothing: hope assures us that they are in the good and strong hands of God. Love is stronger than death", the Pope emphasised. If we let ourselves be supported by this faith, "the experience of bereavement can generate a stronger solidarity in family ties, a new openness to the suffering of other families, a new fraternity with those families who are born and reborn in hope".

Faith gives us birth and rebirth in hope, reiterated Francis, recalling the passage from the Gospel in which Jesus revives the widower's son, restoring him to his mother. "This is our hope", he exclaimed. "Jesus will restore to us all our dear ones who have passed away, He will return them to us and we will meet them again. ... Let us remember this gesture of Jesus ... as the Lord will do the same with the loved ones in our family". This faith, he said, "protects us from a nihilistic vision of death, as well as from the false consolations of the world, 'so that the Christian truth does not risk mixing itself with myths of various types'", giving way to rites of superstition, ancient or modern".


