OUR LADY OF USAMBARA SISTERS

The Mission Co-op Appeal will be held on the weekend of July 15/16

The Sisters of Our Lady of Usambara is a growing congregation of African nuns over 600 nuns, whose work is caring for the needs of the poorest and most deprived people in the northeastern region of Tanzania. Rt. Rev. Bishop Eugene Arthurs founded the congregation in collaboration with Precious Blood Sisters CPS to address the needs of the local church within the diocese. To date the sisters have expanded services outside of the diocese. Our areas of ministries include teaching religious education to young people; providing services to the poor and the sick, and educating young women in schools and colleges.

Also, the sisters provide food and shelter to the poor and the needy people. Run orphanages for helpless children who have lost their parents due to HIV/AIDS, malaria and other killer diseases. Serve the malnourished and street kids. Provide medical services.

Provide two years catechetical and theological training to the laity and young professed sisters. Formation of postulants and novices. On going formation for both sisters and laity so, as to prepare them to serve Gods people in various settings in Tanzania. Water is the big problem in most of our ministries. In schools students spend a lot of time walking to a long distance to collect water.

Being the local congregation with local nuns as members, we understand difficulties, problems and opportunities within the community we serve. Our problem is shortage of resources to serve people.
