#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We have been informed through the Office of the Western Pastoral Region, Most Reverend John A. Boissonneau, D.D., that the English Translation of the Revised Roman Missal and General Instruction will take effect in dioceses throughout Canada on the First Sunday of Advent (November 27/28, 2011). Archbishop Collins has authorized that parishes may begin to learn the new, sung mass settings and employ them in the Liturgy as of September 25, 2011.

Since this requires major changes in our musical style, I am inviting all our choir directors for a meeting at the Rectory on Thursday (July 21) starting at 7:30 PM to map out our parish strategy so our community will be prepared for this transition.

I intend to organize a series of Catechesis based on the new Liturgy once we have access to the materials from the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) in September. I will keep you posted throughout the summer for new developments. We are in exciting times and from what I gather the new Liturgical translation will provide us with a richer and deeper understanding and appreciation of our Catholic Faith.

#### Pope Benedict's 60th Anniversary of Priestly Ordination

Our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI will celebrate his anniversary on June 29, the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul. In honor of his anniversary, we are invited to participate in Eucharistic Adoration with the intention of praying for the sanctification of the clergy and for the gift of new and holy priestly vocations.
