

Pastor's Desk

The Gaelic word for family is translated literally as “those who eat together” just like the word “companion” from two Latin words: com (with) and panis (bread). And if you have ever had the experience of being seated at a table with a complete stranger in a busy restaurant, you know that some of the uncomfortableness comes from the fact that eating together implies some kind of connection that in this case you don't have. The sharing of food and drink is really the sharing of lives: stories told between mouthfuls and advice passed with the pepper. Eating and drinking together creates and sustains communion.

And so we turn to God and pray at the table before eating and drinking. The food and drink is itself a gift from our provident God, the first farmer, who sowed the forests and planted the prairies and husbanded all the animals and stocked the seas; the ancient gardener who planted Eden. That would be reason enough to pause and say thank you and yet there is more.

Not only is the food and drink a gift from God who provides; the eating and the drinking is a way to be with God. Jesus knew this. And because of this, he made the meal the vehicle of his sacrifice and risen presence. Here, at this holy table, we obey his command: “Eat and drink in memory of me.” But not only here, also at home: when we take our daily bread at our own tables, we remember Christ. And our daily bread is made holy and our daily cup is consecrated, and our own tables become altars where God sits down with us.

We lift up our hearts to God here, around the church's table, the Lord's table, because we learn to do so at home, around the kitchen table and the dining room table. We give thanks and praise to God here, over this bread and wine, because we learn to give thanks and praise at home, over spaghetti and spinach, coffee and cola.

So lift up your plate and your cup at home. And whether you live alone or with others, raise your eyes to heaven and say, “Bless us, O Lord, and these your gifts, which we are about to receive, from your bounty, through Christ our Lord. Amen.” If you do, if we all do, our hearts will be true when we lift up this bread and raise this cup in the memory of the one who called us here, the one who loved us to the death and more.


