Continuing a 36-year tradition of generosity and community involvement, our parish is extending a helping hand to those in need in our community and beyond with the launch of our local ShareLife Campaign.

ShareLife, the annual charitable appeal of the Catholic Archdiocese of Toronto, raises funds to provide outreach and care



to those in need through a network of Catholic agencies. Last year, more than 250,000 people received compassionate professional service from ShareLife agencies. Our parish campaign will help ensure those services remain available for everyone in the community, regardless of their background or religious affiliation.

The Archdiocese of Toronto is home to 1.9 million Catholics in 225 parishes, stretching from Toronto to Georgian Bay and from Mississauga to Oshawa. Our goal is to raise \$20,000 to contribute to ShareLife's \$12.3M Parish Campaign.

ShareLife funding ensures that people have ready access to faith-informed counseling services through the network of Catholic Family Services offices. The Importance and Meaning of the Scrutinies of the Lenten Season

As part of our observance of the Season of Lent, we will accompany our catechumens in the Rite of Scrutiny. It is important that we understand the purpose of these rites. The word itself, "scrutiny," carries all kinds of connotations and meanings. At first hearing our Elect and Candidates might feel frightened and anxious over the impending self-discoveries.



Too often we focus on "sin" and that which needs to be rooted out in our heads and the heart of our culture forgetting that there is another purpose of the Scrutinies. Paragraph 141 of *The Rite of Christian Initiation* reminds us that puts the purpose in plain language: "The Scrutinies are meant to uncover then heal all that is weak...then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. The Scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the Elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life."

In our preparation for the Scrutinies we must ask our Elect where they are in need of purification but also give them the encouragement of God's enlightenment. We do not wish to just "uncover the weakness" but we must also ensure our Elect that God will change their hearts and bring a new light to shadow places in their lives.

Having looked at the "weaknesses" we also need to give thanks for that which is "upright, good and strong." These personal gifts are given to us and also given to the church. The talents given to each member are meant for the building of the body of Christ and it is now the desire of our Elect to use these talents for the good of the community.

Indeed, the renewal of our Elect affects the life of the whole community. The Scrutinies are never meant to be self-disclosure and judgment. The Scrutinies are a time to "empty ourselves" so that Christ may enter into our hearts and be transformed.


