

Thank you to our Parish Sacramental Preparation Team

The sacramental preparation of our young people is very important to our parish community. We express our gratitude to all our volunteer catechists who help our young people encounter the risen Jesus through the sacraments of First Reconciliation, First Communion, and Confirmation.

More than 4,000 young people have been assisted by our Volunteer Catechists since they started their ministry nine years ago.



The old tabernacle that you see on the left was given to us at a time when we were still not certain whether we will be given permission to construct by the City and the Archdiocese. We were also not certain whether we will be able to build in one phase or several phases due to financial constraints. The arrival of the old tabernacle was like a sign from heaven that the Eucharistic Lord, who once lived in this old tabernacle, wants to have a new home. It is my hope, as your pastor, to bring back the beauty of this tabernacle. I plan to have the front door double or triple-toned: silver for the angels, the cross in gold, and the background in

brass. It will also be covered with wood all around with Eucharistic symbols. It will be placed on a stand in our Chapel of Adoration behind the sanctuary, slightly recessed underneath the middle arch, but visible to the whole church. The cost of the restoration and the stand is estimated to be \$25,000. If you would like to assist in this project, a pledge form is available at the desk. Pray the Rosary as a family

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, speaks...

In our catechesis on Christian hope, we now reflect on Mary Magdalen as an apostle of the hope brought by the Gospel.

Saint John tells us on Easter morning Mary had gone to the tomb of Jesus; she saw that it was empty, and returned to tell this news to Peter and the other disciples. Returning to the tomb, yet still not understanding what had happened, Mary encounters the Risen Lord, but does not recognize him until he calls her by name.

This first appearance of Jesus after rising from the dead is thus something intensely personal. We know that just as he did with Mary Magdalen, so too Jesus calls each of us by name and fills us with joy at his presence.

Our encounter with him brings freedom and opens up new vistas of life; it transforms our world and brings undying hope. The risen Lord tells Mary not to cling to him, but to go and tell the good news of his resurrection to the others.

Mary Magdalen thus becomes the apostle of Christian hope. By her prayers, may we be encounter anew the risen Lord, who calls us by name, turns our sorrow into joy, and sends us forth to proclaim by our lives that he is truly risen.
