I will be back from my home visit on Monday, May 23, God willing. I am writing this bulletin from my hotel window at a former US military base in the Philippines. For the first time, I took the road alone to meet with my two priest-friends. In the past, I dared not drive here... more often than not, the road signs are mere suggestions. My patience was really tested. There's the bus that does not signal when stopping to pick up passengers, a tricycle without head lights, and a cart that appears from nowhere. I never thought I was capable of speaking foul language until I hit the road. What an experience and an eye opener!
