

PARISH SUNDAY BULLETIN

Several saints have been raised to the Altar this Sunday. Last week, we featured St. Kateri Tekawitha, the Lily of the Mohawks. This week, we feature St. Pedro Calungsod, patron of young people.

On January 27, 2000 the Decree of Authentic Martyrdom was promulgated by Pope John Paul II at the Clementine Hall of the Papal Palace.

On March 5, 2000 Pedro Calungsod was declared "Blessed" by Pope (now Blessed) John Paul II at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. The Holy Father praised Blessed Pedro Calungsod, saying:



"From his childhood, Pedro Calungsod declared himself unwaveringly for Christ and responded generously to his call. Young people today can draw encouragement and strength from the example of Pedro, whose love of Jesus inspired him to devote his teenage years to teaching the faith as a lay catechist. Leaving family and friends behind, Pedro willingly accepted the challenge put to him by Fr. Diego de San Vitores to join him on the Mission to the Chamorros.

In a spirit of faith, marked by strong Eucharistic and Marian devotion, Pedro undertook the demanding work asked of him and bravely faced the many obstacles and difficulties he met. In the face of imminent danger, Pedro would not forsake Fr. Diego, but as a "good soldier of Christ" preferred to die at the missionary's side.

Today, Blessed Pedro Calungsod intercedes for the young and he challenges them. Young friends, do not hesitate to follow the example of Pedro, who "pleased God and was loved by him" (Wisdom 4:10) and who, having come to perfection in so short a time, lived a full life."

"Christians today often do not even know the central core of their Catholic faith, the Creed, thus leaving the way open to certain forms of syncretism and religious relativism, with no clarity about which truths must be believed and the salvific uniqueness of Christianity. ... We must go back to God, to the God of Jesus Christ, we must rediscover the message of the Gospel and cause it to enter more deeply into our minds and our daily lives.
