By now, most of you have returned from your summer activities and your children are back in school. I am still with my parents in the Philippines as I prepare this Parish Bulletin, but will soon start my return journey. God willing, I will be with you on Monday, September 11. I wish to thank the Very Reverend Msgr. Terence D'Souza and Fr. Idara Otu for looking after the parish during my absence.

On the Sacraments

With the new school year that has just begun, our parish invites the young people of our parish, in Catholic, Public, or Private Schools, to register for the Sacraments of Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation. First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are offered starting in Grade two and Confirmation is in Grade Seven and beyond. A copy of the Baptismal Certificate is required to register. If the child is not baptized, we recommend the Rite of Christian Initiation for Children as the path to follow. Registration for First Reconciliation and First Communion will be held on the weekends at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School September 30/October 1 and October 7/8. For the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Registration will be on the weekend of October 21/22 and October 28/29. We ask everyone for their cooperation. Registration must be done in person. We will not accept registrations via Fax or email. Thank you for your cooperation.

On the Church Building Project

Church construction continues and the date of occupancy might be postponed for another week. We are hoping for the first Sunday of Advent (December 2/3), but we have been advised that we might only be able to offer Holy Mass in the Building starting on the weekend of December 16/17. I will inform you of any development upon the advise of Melloul-Blamey, the construction firm.

Meanwhile, please continue to support financially our Building project. We encourage those who have pledged via the Family of Faith to fulfill their commitment. For those who wish to make a pledge, we have forms available for you to complete. You can fulfill your pledge via credit card, post-dated cheques, or using your Building Fund Envelope.


