Sacramental Preparation

First Reconciliation/First Communion

We invite our young people from Grade 2 and older to register for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist starting on the weekend of October 1/2, before and after all the Masses that we celebrate at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School. We require a copy of the Baptismal Certificate in order to register.

If the child has not been baptized. The child needs to be registered for RCIC to prepare him/her for the Easter Sacraments.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Our Grade 7 and over are invited to register for the Sacrament of Confirmation starting on the weekend of October 22/23 before and after all the Masses that we celebrate at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Secondary School. A copy of the Baptismal Certificate is required. We also expect that the young person completed his/her has First Reconciliation and First Communion. If not, the young person will have to register for RCIC to fulfill all the requirements.
