Whenever we look to Mary, we come to believe once again in the revolutionary nature of love and tenderness", he emphasised. Like Mary, we want to be a Church who can accompany all those 'pregnant' situations of our people, committed to life, to culture, to society, not washing our hands but rather walking with our brothers and sisters.
