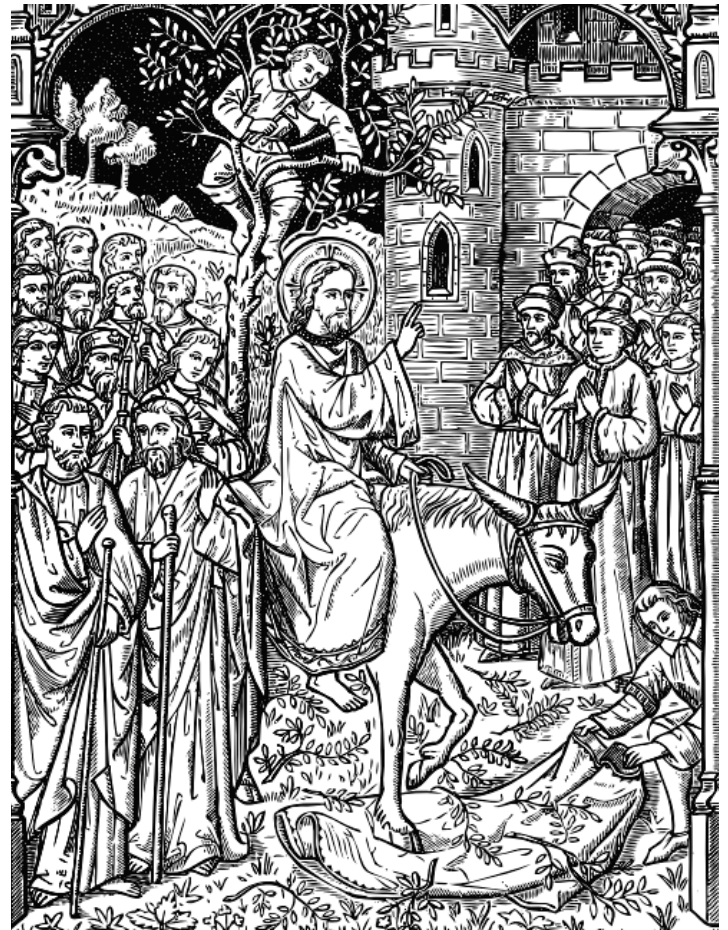

EASTER VIGIL

The rubrics of the Roman Missal remind us that the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday Night is the "greatest and most noble of all solemnities". On this holy night, the Church keeps watch, celebrating the resurrection of Christ in the sacraments and awaiting His return in glory. It is the turning point of the Triduum. It begins with The Service of Light, where the Easter Proclamation is sung following the blessing of the fire. Then follows the Liturgy of the Word, and Liturgy of Baptism where we welcome members of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults into the Church through Baptism and Confirmation, culminating in the Liturgy of the Eucharist where we celebrate Holy Communion together as one community. All are welcome to join on **Saturday, April 20, 8:30PM**. Reception to follow in Parish Halls.
