Time is short.

#### Offered by Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Archdiocese of Toronto & Continuing Education, University of St. Michael's College CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Level I: Foundations Course: Children Ages Birth - 6 This introductory course will explore the foundations of an approach to the religious education/formation of children in the Toronto Archdiocese known as the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.

It will present the orientation to the key issues fundamental to this ministry with children in early childhood. It will also introduce the foundational Biblical and Liturgical themes, which we present to children along with some hands-on experience with selected catechetical materials hand made to nurture children's prayer.

This 90 hour course, held over ten months is especially designed for those who are interested or already involved in caring for the spiritual lives of children; in the home, parish and school setting. It is also a prerequisite for further adult formation courses in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (Certificate Program, Levels II and III).
