JUST DO IT

"What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if you have faith but do not have good works?" Living the Christian life is more than saying the right thing; we call that orthodoxy, but also doing the right thing, orthopraxy. We give thanks to God for the gift of faith and the love God has for us, by sharing His mercy and love with others. We do that work in our personal relationships and in the way our faith community responds to the Lord's commission to bring the Good News of the Reign of God to the world. If you look at this bulletin or check our website, you will find that the St. Basil's community offers many opportunities to express your faith in action.

We share our faith and pass it on from generation to generation through participating in activities such as the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and sacramental preparation for Baptism, First Eucharist, Confirmation and Christian Marriage, and



the RCIA. We publicly proclaim our faith when we gather together for prayer and worship. Readers, servers, extraordinary ministers of Communion, and members of our choirs, greeters and ushers activate their faith by serving the community at prayer. Some members visit the sick and homebound and bring them Holy Communion. Others come together to support each other and the parish community through prayer, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and faith sharing. You may want to consider participating in these and other parish-based activities as a way of expressing your faith.

But, on a day to day, basis each of us is called and commissioned to bring the Good News of God’s love and mercy by what we say and do in our homes and neighbourhoods, the places we work and study and the way we treat others with respect and dignity. As St. James writes to us today, “...I by my works will show you my faith”.
