#### ADVENT A SEASON OF JOYFUL EXPECTATION!



This new season is marked by a change in liturgical colour from green to violet. The Church reminds us that "Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which

the first coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight."

Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the General Roman Calendar, par. 39. During Advent, we are reminded that we are to be ready to welcome Christ in our brothers and sisters and to prepare to celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation: God with us.

# PRAYER FOR THE FIRST WEEK OF ADVENT



Before your family meal, light the first candle on your Advent wreath. If you do not have an Advent wreath you may light a taper before you pray.

O God, as we light this candle, remind us of the need to bring the light of hope into the world. Help us to stay awake to the needs of others by seeing with our eyes and hearts. Give us courage to reach out in hope to the lonely in our schools, parishes and communities. Amen

#### RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION: A Sign of our Communion with God and Union with Others



Beginning the first Sunday of Advent at every liturgy, we shall be invited to share both the Body and Blood of Christ. It is always good for those of us who

come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to receive Holy Communion.

At the time of Holy Communion, when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, *"The Body of Christ"*, you will reply, *"Amen"*. It is important to note that the only appropriate response is *Amen*. The Church expects that *Amen* is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion.

After saying **Amen** you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood you will move to the Minister of the Chalice who will say, *"The Blood of Christ"*, you will reply, *"Amen"* and take a sip from the chalice. You will not bow a second time for the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture. (GIRM, paragraph 160) The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head. As a sign of our unity and respect for the Body of Christ we join in singing the Communion hymn. After everyone has shared in Holy Communion there will be a time of silence for prayer.
