

59 to fast on Ash Wednesday



and Good Friday. To fast is to eat one main meal and not to eat between meals. Those with medical conditions are exempt from the call to fast. Here in the parish on Ash Wednesday there will be a 12:10 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Throughout the season, there will an additional Mass each Wednesday at 12:10 p.m.




