# DAYS FOR GIRLS



Days for Girls, Barrie, in conjunction with St. Mary's CWL, are holding their next workshops on the following dates:

Wednesdays, February 7 and 21; March 7 and 21; and April 11 and 25.

We meet in the hall from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Brown Bag lunch. Coffee and tea are provided. The sustainable feminine sanitary kits we make will keep a girl in school 2-4 years in developing countries. Presently, we are working on a distribution of 150 kits for Haiti. Each kit costs \$15 to make. The kits bring empowerment and dignity to the girls by keeping them in school and are well received around the world.

Our goal for 2016-17 was to make 200 kits. We exceeded this by finishing and distributing 388 kits. They were sent to Haiti, Tanzania, Sierra Leone and Nicaragua.

This year, our plan is to reach 500 kits by April. This can be accomplished with your help.
