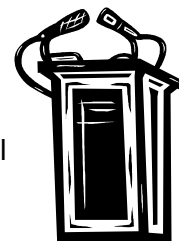

Following there will be a reception in meeting rooms 1 and 3.

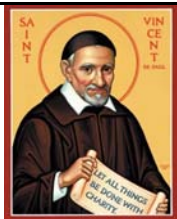


FIRST COMMUNION DEADLINE – TODAY!!

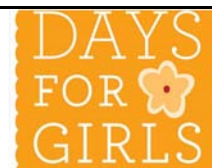
