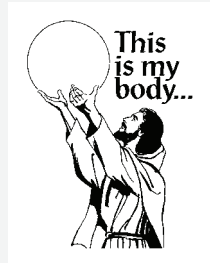

WELCOME REV. MSGR. MARCO LAURENCIC



Effective July 1st, 2016, we are pleased and honoured to welcome Rev. Msgr. Marco Laurencic to St. Mary's as our new Pastor. Below is his biography for your information.

After completing my studies at St.

Augustine's Seminary, I was ordained by Archbishop Philip Pocock on September 10, 1977 in my home parish of St. Joseph's in Streetsville (Mississauga).

My first assignment was at Holy Spirit Parish in Agincourt, a suburb of Toronto, from 1977 to 1981. St. Jane Francis Parish in Downsview was my next appointment from 1981-1983. From 1983-85 I was the Vice-Rector of St. Michael's Cathedral where I met Pope John Paul II during his visit to Canada in 1984. In December of 1985 I was appointed by Cardinal Emmett Carter as Director of Vocations and Rector of Serra House, a residence where potential candidates for the priesthood came to study, pray and discern their vocation to the diocesan priesthood. In January of 1991 I was appointed Pastor of Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, in North York by Cardinal Aloysius Ambrozic. During my tenure at Annunciation, I also served as Archdiocesan Spiritual Director to the Catholic Women's League.

In 2001 I was appointed by Cardinal Ambrozic as the Director of Priests' Personnel, a position I held until July of 2012. As Director I resided first at Blessed Sacrament Parish, Toronto and then St. Cecilia's Parish also in Toronto. In 2004, His Holiness Pope John Paul II named me a Chaplain to His Holiness (CHH) with the title Monsignor.

After completing eleven years as Director of Priests' Personnel, Cardinal Collins granted me a sabbatical year where I travelled and completed a sabbatical programme at the University of California (Berkley). In 2013 upon completion of my sabbatical I was appointed Associate Pastor at St. Anselm Parish in East York and in 2014 I was appointed Pastor of the parish. In addition, I am Chairman of Zone 3 (North Toronto) and Vice Chair of the Council of Priests.
