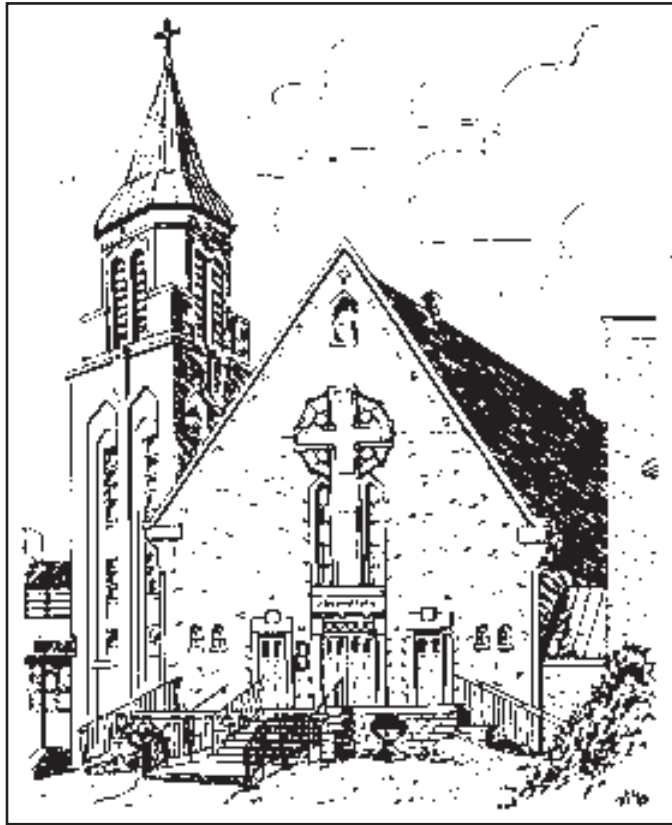

JUBILARIAN 2010

Reverend Pedro Arana, born at Basud, Tabaco in the Philippines on October 4th 1942. **Fr. Pedro was ordained to the priesthood by Pope Paul VI in Manila on November 28, 1970.** In his native country, Fr. Arana taught at St. Gregory the Great Seminary in Tabaco, was Director of the Diocesan Social Centre in Albay Province and was awarded a Study Grant by the Institut pour le Développement des peuples, Paris, France. He has exercised parish ministry at two parishes in the Philippines and here in Canada at Blessed Sacrament, Cornwall, and at St. Brigid's Parish, Ottawa. Incardinated in the Archdiocese of Ottawa on October 15, 1997, he has been, since 2006, Pastor of Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, Vanier.

**DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE —
See your Gift Grow**

On Solidarity Sunday – March 21 - the faithful in Canada made a sacrificial offering to assist the poor countries of the world through Development and Peace, the official charitable organization of the Canadian Catholic Bishops. Development and Peace's regular program, elaborated with its partners, currently spans more than 33 countries in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Middle East. They also take part in emergency relief and reconstruction work in response to humanitarian crisis. Their emphasis has been on Haiti throughout the Spring of 2010. In 2009, they supported Haiti with eight projects and four emergency aids for the total amount of \$600,000. Since January 2010, more than \$19,000,000 was raised in Canada, \$500,000 of which was contributed by the faithful of the Diocese of Ottawa. The funds are sent to Haiti through Caritas Internationalis, the international emergency relief network of the Catholic Church. This amount is phenomenal, however these emergency collections must not infringe upon the frequent donations for long term projects in countries in the Global South. This year's goal is to collect \$400,000 from the Ottawa Diocese and \$100,000 from the Gatineau Diocese. This also includes the amounts collected through the Share Year-Round Members and the Share Lent Campaign. - Richard Pommainville
