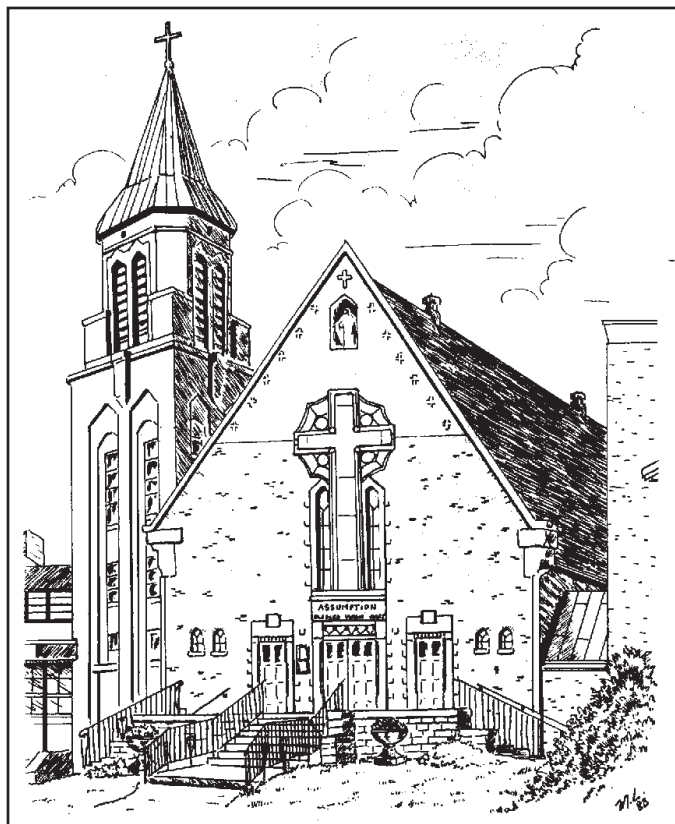

PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

FUNERALS - Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial.

SAINT ANDRE BESSETTE, C.S.C:

Alfred Bessette was born August 9, 1845 in the town of Saint-Gregoire, southeast of Montreal, Canada. One of the ten children, he was unable to attend school regularly because he continuously struggled with poor health. By the time he was twelve, both his mother and father had passed away. In 1870, Alfred entered the Holy Cross novitiate and took the name of Frere Andre. He spent almost four years as a porter or doorman at College Notre Dame in Montreal. Despite the many personal trials he faced and the simple nature of his work. God used him as a powerful instrument of his grace, especially to the sick and the afflicted who visited him. This humble Brother, whose simplicity reminds of our seraphic father Francis, inspires us to live out our Franciscan minoritas in this new friary named to honour Frere Andre. During his lifetime, Frere Andre was devoted to Saint Joseph and he became known as the "Miracle Man" of Montreal. In 1904, he founded the world renowned St. Joseph's Oratory, today the largest church in Canada. He died January 6, 1937 and more than one million persons paid him final homage. Pope John Paul II beatified Brother Andre in May, 1982. Twenty eight years later, in October 2010, Pope Benedict XVI canonized him as the first Canadian born male saint, a heroic witness to Christ, a heavenly intercessor and model from whom we can all learn from.

BLESSING AND DEDICATION OF THE NEW FRANCISCAN FRIARY, ST. ANDRE BESSETTE:

Archbishop Terrence Prendergast, S.J. will preside at a mass and blessing of the new Franciscan Friary, St. Andre Bessette of our parish. The mass will be on **Tuesday, Aug. 22nd at 5:00 PM** with the dedication and blessing to follow. The mass is celebrated on the occasion of the centenary of the founding of the Militia of the Immaculate, an association founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe, one of our Franciscan Friars who gave his life for another at Auschwitz in World War II. The homilist for the mass will be the Minister Provincial of the Franciscans, the Very Rev. James McCurry. All are welcome to the mass and dedication..

PETITION AGAINST "BUBBLE ZONE" LEGISLATION:

The provincial government plans to introduce the "bubble zone" legislation that would prohibit pro-life counsellors and any form of pro-life expression from coming within a certain distance of Ontario abortion facilities, including public sidewalks. This is an infringement of Canadians' fundamental rights under Section 2 of the Charter of Rights and Freedoms. The presence of pro-lifers at abortion facilities is peaceful, prayerful and does not impede the "customers" from entering the facilities. We ask for your support by signing the petition papers at the entrances of the church, by following the instructions as stated, in order that these petition papers may be forwarded to the Provincial Attorney General of Ontario. **Your support is so important for all Christians in Canada, please sign the forms.** (Joan Lepage, Pro-Life Representative).
