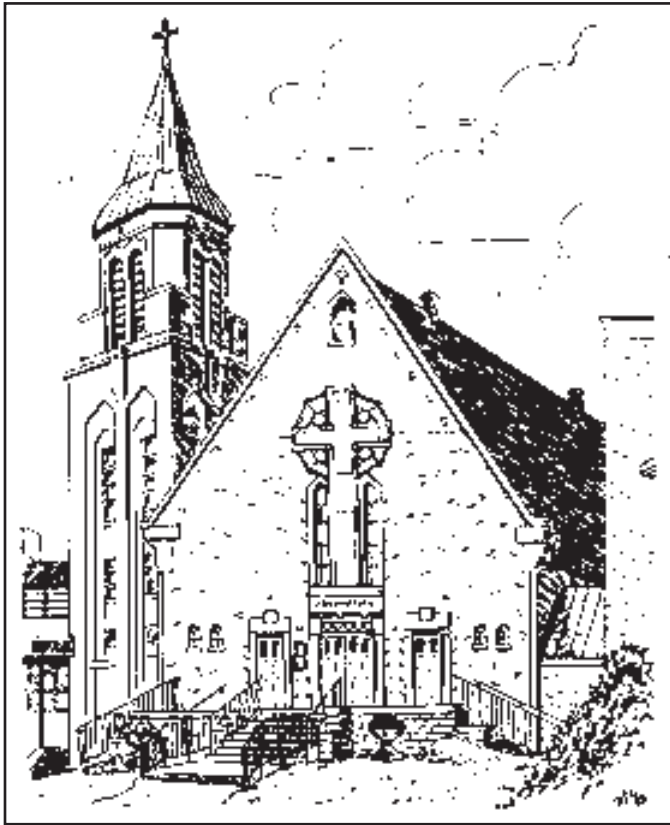

**ASH WEDNESDAY / THE BEGINNING OF LENT**

Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 is Ash Wednesday. This day is to be observed as a day of fast and abstinence from meat. The laws of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Ashes will be distributed at the 8 am. morning Mass and also at the 7 pm. evening Mass, Wed. February 17<sup>th</sup>. **Stations of the Cross will be at 7:30 am. every Friday during Lent beginning Friday, Feb. 19<sup>th</sup>. Last year's palms may be brought back to the church to be burnt for the ashes used on Ash Wednesday.**
