CARE FOR CREATION – AGREEMENT AT PARIS CLIMATE CONFERENCE: An agreement has been reached that moves us towards the end of the fossil fuel era. While there was a failure to address some key issues such as climate finance for developing countries, Paris is seen as a turning point as we seek solutions called for by Pope Francis in his encyclical.
