PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SPIRITUAL COUNSELING -
by appointment.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

Saint of the Week

St. Irenaeus of Lyons (June 28)

St. Irenaeus (125-203) was a disciple of St. Polycarp of Smyrna. At a time when Gnostic sects threatened to undermine Christianity through perversion of Christian theology and philosophy, St. Irenaeus denounced these heretics and safeguarded the unity of belief. He succeeded the martyred St. Pothinus as Bishop of Lyon.

A Message from the Pastor

Peace and goodness!

This Sunday, we celebrate the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, the precursor of the Lord!

In the calendar of the Church, there are only three persons whose birth is celebrated. Our Lord Jesus Christ, His Mother Mary and St. John the Baptist. This is because they are directly involved in salvation history.

In the gospel of St. Luke, we find the two annunciations one after the other: the coming of St. John the Baptist and the coming of Jesus. Luke placed the two events with a very similar structure. Zechariah lost his capacity to speak not only as a punishment for his disbelief but also to highlight the coming of the "word" and the "voice". After the birth of John, he regained his voice and he sang a song of thanksgiving to God.

The birth of St. John challenges us to use our voice to proclaim the kingdom of God. To sow the seed of love, to search about the truth and to proclaim it, and To build the Church of Jesus by giving our time and talents for the common good. We should not be afraid or ashamed to proclaim our faith even if it will cost us our lives.

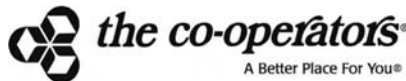
