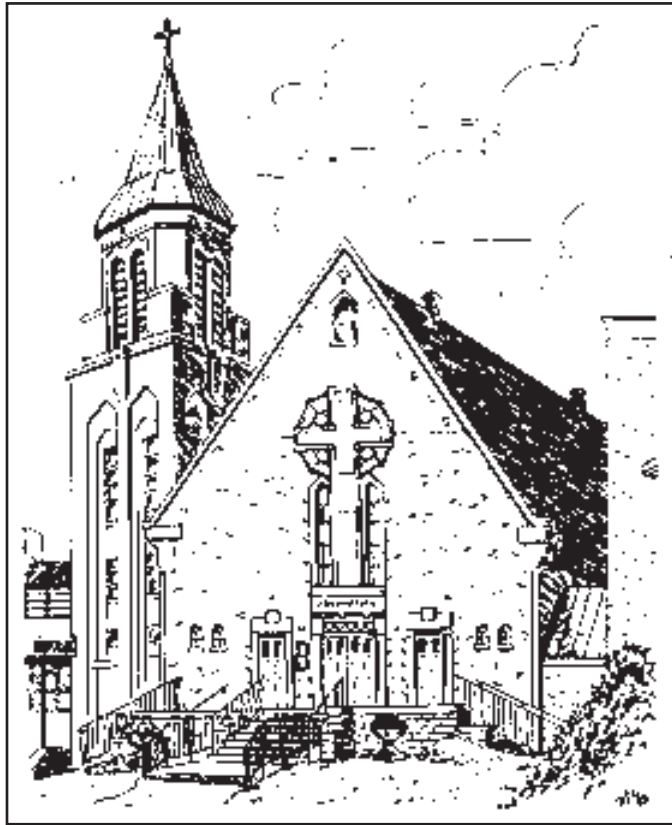

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

TRAINING FOR EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS

Is God calling you to serve Him as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMHC) at Mass or to carry the Body of Christ (Viaticum) to the sick or shut-ins? In accordance to the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be "truly suited". This means that the person must be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church and should not be living in an invalid marriage or in any other state of grave sin. The second requirement of the Church is that EMHC's should receive careful preparation" and be commissioned in this Holy Ministry. To this end, a training session for all those who meet the requirements and would like to serve in this ministry will be provided on Saturday March 31, 2012 starting at 9:30 am in the Church followed by commissioning at the 4:00 pm Mass on the same day.
