SANTACRUZAN 2010

Santacruzán will be held on **Sunday, May 30, 2010**. It is with the approval of the San Lorenzo Ruiz Ecclesial Movement of Assumption Parish to continue with the annual event. Santacruzán is a religious festival with strong Spanish influence celebrated in May, in all cities, towns and villages in the Philippines and around the world by Filipinos. Santacruzán takes its name from the Holy Cross which touched the life of Empress Helena, mother of Constantine the Great. At the site of the crucifixion, Helen's team found three crosses. Helena's servant touched all three, and one cured the servant's sickness. That was the cross of Jesus. This year the Hermana Mayor Emila Munro represents the Empress. She is joined by many in her "Sagala" of ladies and consorts and children. After the 12 noon Mass, the Hermana Mayor will lead a procession in the streets around the Assumption Church.
