PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

St. Ludovico of Casoria, Pastor

St. Ludovico was born in Casoria near Naples. He entered the Franciscan Order in 1832. He taught Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics for several years. In 1847, he had a mystical experience, after which he dedicated his life entirely to the poor and infirm. He said, “Christ’s love has wounded my heart”. This love prompted him to great acts of Charity. The process of his beatification began within five months of his death. He was beatified in 1993 and canonized in 2014.

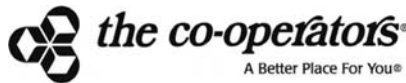

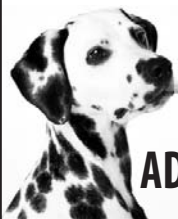
