PASTORAL CARE

BAPTISMS - If you are a registered parishioner of Assumption Parish (or another parish) and attend Mass regularly, there is no waiting period. You may call the Parish Office to schedule a date and must attend a baptism preparation session prior to the baptism. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your Pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register, attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

CONFESSIONS - 15 minutes before all Weekday Masses, as well as 3:30 p.m. on Saturday; or by appointment with the priest.

MARRIAGES - One of the couple must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK & COMMUNION FOR SHUT-INS -

Anyone who wishes to receive Anointing of the Sick or Holy Communion please call the office to have your name put on the list.

St. Bede The Venerable, Priest & Doctor of the Church (May 25)

Born in England, St. Bede (672-735) entered the Benedictine monastery of Sts. Peter and Paul, where he was "the most observant and the happiest of all monks." His writings are so replete with sound doctrine he was called "Venerable" while still alive. He wrote commentaries on Holy Scripture and treatises on theology and history. Called the Father of English history, he popularized the dating of events "before Christ" (BC) and "in the year of the Lord" ("anno Domini"; AD). He died at Jarrow, England.

The readings for this Sunday, the fifth in Easter, helps us to be aware of the mystery of our faith revealed in the Church for the Church.

The Church, the bride of the bridegroom who was born at the foot of the Cross, is calling and embracing all her children and leading them back to God. As a hen would gather her chicks, so the Church gathers us into one fold.

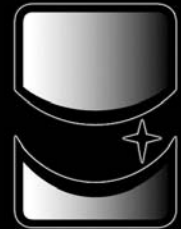

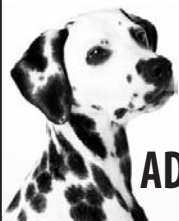
