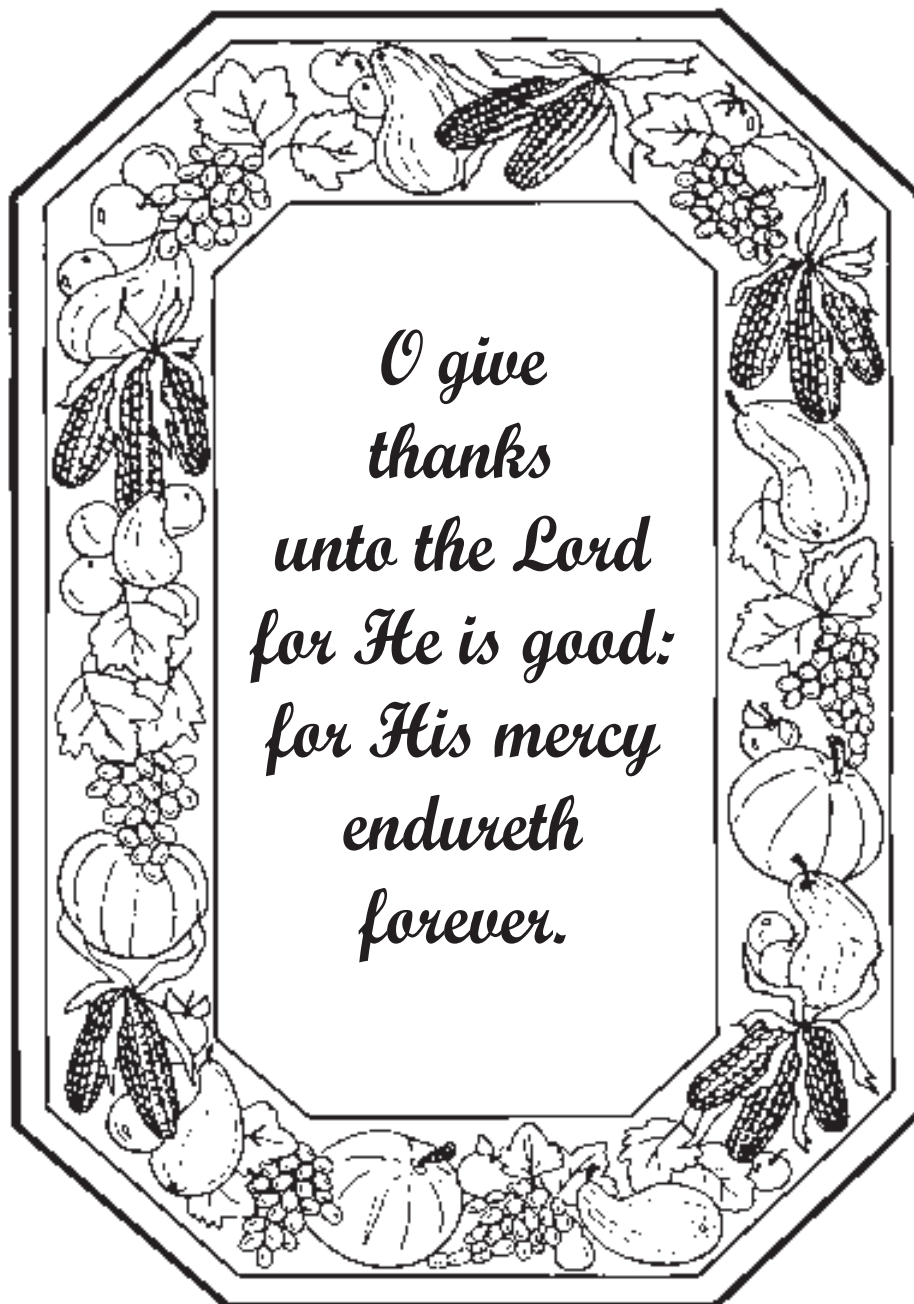

TEMPORAL COUNCIL NEWS

Church Heating System: Two boilers installation, the interior piping and the electrical panel upgrade are done. The contractor CG Plumbing are waiting for the new chimney and the condensate tank. Forecast for firing up the heating system is the week of Oct. 14th.

Repairs and Maintenance: During the past week of several days of rain, there was no sign of water leakage in the lower hall so the expense in resolving it has been justified. The solution is a long term one, and we do not expect any more problems in the foreseeable future. The return condensate piping that ends underneath the stage lower hall is a new installation.

Joint Council Meeting: Was held on Sept. 16th, 2009. The next meeting is on Nov. 25th, 2009, 7:00 pm in the lower Church hall. The meeting on Sept 16th, was focused on raising funds for our Reserve Fund. Events were: the Sportsfest on Aug 22nd, which raised \$700. The San Lorenzo Ruiz celebration Sept. 26th raised \$989.69. The McCann Family Musical occurred on Oct 4th, hosted by Assumption CWL, \$2,000.00 was raised. Future events are: a Fall Sportsfest, sponsored by KOC on October 17th; a Multicultural show on November 1st, hosted by the Filipino Canadian Seniors; and the Orpheus Choir on November 29th, hosted by CWL.
