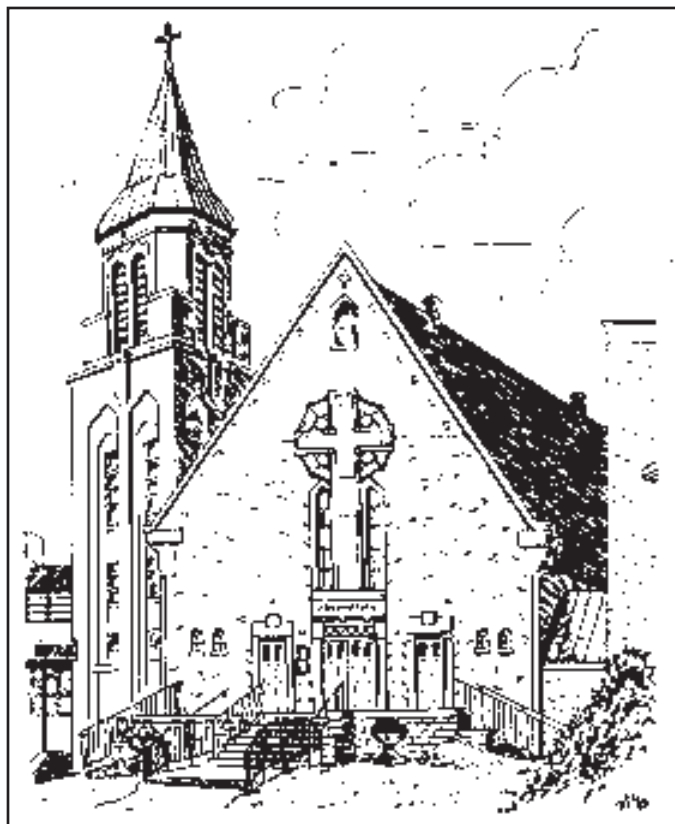

SACRISTANS NEEDED: Back-up Sacristans are needed for both weekday and weekend Masses. This is a wonderful opportunity to volunteer in your Parish. They prepare for Mass by: unlocking the church doors one half-hour before Mass; washing the vessels to be used for the Eucharistic Celebration; placing the vessels along with the corporal, pall and purifiers on the credence table; preparing the appropriate number of hosts, wine and water; placing water, washbowl and towel on the credence table; arranging the Liturgical books (Roman Missal and Lectionary) in accordance with the readings and prayers indicated in the Ordo; putting out the microphones and turning on the amplifier and the lights of the church; putting all items away after Mass; closing the lights and amplifier, and locking all doors to secure the church. In addition to the above, weekday Sacristans may also be required to act as Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Training will be provided.
