

CWL GENERAL MEETING: The CWL of Assumption Parish will be holding our first council meeting of the new season on **Tuesday**, **September 16**th at **7:00 pm** in the parish hall. We will also be collecting baby items for St. Joe's Women Shelter as discussed during our spring meeting. Refreshments will be served and we look forward to seeing you.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE FROM SEPTEMBER 24th TO NOVEMBER 2nd, 2014: Our "Forty Days for Life Campaign" begins on Wednesday, September 24th. People of faith are invited to participate in prayer, fasting and peaceful vigil to end abortion. Every day for forty days, people will gather for one hour in silent vigil from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm across from the abortion clinic on 65 Bank Street. Each parish is asked to participate and our day of vigil is **Wednesday**, **September 24**th. There are sign-up sheets at the entrances of the church for you to record your name and telephone number, and the time-slot of your preference. If you wish to extend your time to more than one hour, that would be fine as well. We would like to see all the time slots filled if possible. Remember, there is free bus transportation for all seniors on Wednesdays. For more information, or if you have any questions, kindly contact our Pro-Life Representative, Joan Lepage. INSTALLATION OF MANNY BELOY: Manny Beloy of our Parish will be installed as **Acolyte** during the **4:00 pm Mass** on **Saturday**, **September 20**th. Fr. Geoffrey Kerslake, the Episcopal Vicar of the Archdiocese of Ottawa, will preside over the installation ceremony and he will also be preaching the homily.

FEAST OF SAN LORENZO RUIZ: Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish will be celebrating the **Feast of San Lorenzo Ruiz**, the first Filipino Saint, on **Saturday**, **September 27**th, with a Mass at **7:00 pm**. There will be a reception after Mass and all are welcome.

TRAINING FOR NEW LECTORS: We are planning to provide training for new lectors in the fall. In accordance to the requirements of the Church, those who shall perform these functions must be "truly suited" (GIRM 101). This means that the person should be at least 18 years old, must be a fully initiated Catholic living in communion with the Church, should not be living in an invalid marriage (CCL 1055.1.1, 1056) or in any other state of grave sin (CCL 915, 209.1) and have the ability to read and clearly speak in the language that they are to proclaim the Word of God. If you believe that God is calling you to serve Him in this special ministry please call the Parish Office and leave your name, phone number and e-mail address.

SACRISTANS NEEDED: Back-up Sacristans are needed for both weekday and weekend Masses. This is a wonderful opportunity to volunteer in your Parish. They prepare for Mass by: unlocking the church doors one half-hour before Mass; washing the vessels to be used for the Eucharistic Celebration; placing the vessels along with the corporal, pall and purifiers on the credence table; preparing the appropriate number of hosts, wine and water; placing water, washbowl and towel on the credence table; arranging the Liturgical books (Roman Missal and Lectionary) in accordance with the readings and prayers indicated in the Ordo: putting out the microphones and turning on the amplifier and the lights of the church; putting all items away after Mass; closing the lights and amplifier, and locking all doors to secure the church. In addition to the above, weekday Sacristans may also be required to act as Lectors and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Training will be provided.
