

PASTOR'S DESK

April 24, 2022 - Sunday of Divine Mercy

"Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." (JOHN 20:21)

Peace – the first gift of the risen Lord. Just as Jesus sent the apostles out into the world, so too, He sends us. As disciples of Jesus, we are called to be compassionate and merciful; and not with just those who are our friends, but also with our "enemies." Think of someone in your life who you need to reconcile with. Call them right now or better yet, go visit them.

Beyond the hour on Sunday: Wish you were there!

Many of you have not experienced "**Refuge night**", a night of Adoration, Praise and Worship, and the Blessed Sacrament. Refuge takes place in the Church, at 7:00 p.m., every third Thursday of the month. Since last fall, we have introduced a theme approach, which brings focus and better attendance to this evening liturgy. The last couple of months we have celebrated two wonderful evenings where we received candidates for Easter the Sacraments in the Liturgy of Enrolment. There are 28 candidates for Confirmation and 31 for First Eucharist. Good Friday evening highlighted the Stations of the Cross. Our **next Refuge evening will take place on Thurs. May 17**th and will be the First Session on the Sacrament of Confirmation. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Holy Hour is held each morning, from Monday through to Thursday. Doors open at 7 a.m. Why not stop in before work to experience a few minutes, half an hour or an hour of personal prayer time for yourself. Come Let us Adore HIM! Confession is also available during this time and Mass follows at 8:30 a.m.

Seek the Lord while He is to be found: RCIA is ongoing. If you know of any adult that is wanting to join the RC church, thinking of Baptism and/or Confirmation please let us know. Also, we are seeking out candidates in High School, who because of the pandemic concerns over the last couple of years missed their sacrament at the time it was offered. We are looking at a late fall Confirmation Liturgy for these candidates.

DID you know? Only two families have requested baptism for their child in our parish so far this year. Also there have been no requests or inquiries for weddings, yet resorts, hotels and restaurants are busily booking them. **Note**: the cheapest part of the day is the church and padre! I was reminded of the time in a previous parish, when I offered a couple I knew, a wedding for free and no go. They ended up with a civil wedding and were disappointed with an outdoor event in the fall!

So many new faces are coming to St Augustine Parish. This is good news. In the period leading up to Easter Sunday, we saw many new faces and experienced great attendance at Mass. We are very grateful to the 'Siblings Keepers,' (our parish greeters) for all the effort they put into greeting and welcoming the visitors and new parishioners.

Some thoughts for Easter; Pope Francis:

"Love is continuous contact. It is continuous talking and listening. That is why I insist that we have direct contact with the Gospels... If you do not have contact with the living Christ, the one of the Gospel," Pope Francis says, you will have contact with ideas, doctrines and ideologies about the Gospel, that may or may not have come from Jesus. "Redemption was not done by doctrines, but by a Person." Even if you know all the dogmas, but do not have contact with the Gospel, you will only be Catholic in your head and not in your heart. Being a Catholic, being a Christian, insists Pope Francis, requires contact with Jesus.


