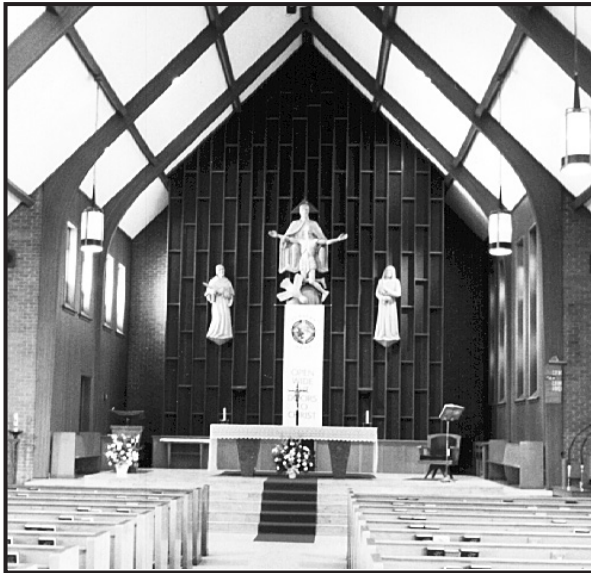

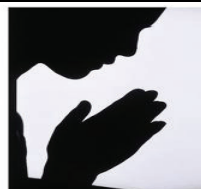

Congratulations to Archbishop Prendergast on the 20th Anniversary of his consecration as Bishop! On April 25th, 1995, Fr. Terry Prendergast SJ was ordained to serve as an auxiliary bishop in the Archdiocese of Toronto. In June of 1998, he became Archbishop of Halifax. Nine years later, Archbishop Prendergast became our archbishop on May 14th, 2007 and subsequently received the pallium from Pope Benedict XVI on June 29th. We will honour Archbishop Prendergast's 20th Anniversary as bishop during the celebration of our Archdiocesan Feast Day on June 11th at Notre Dame Cathedral.
