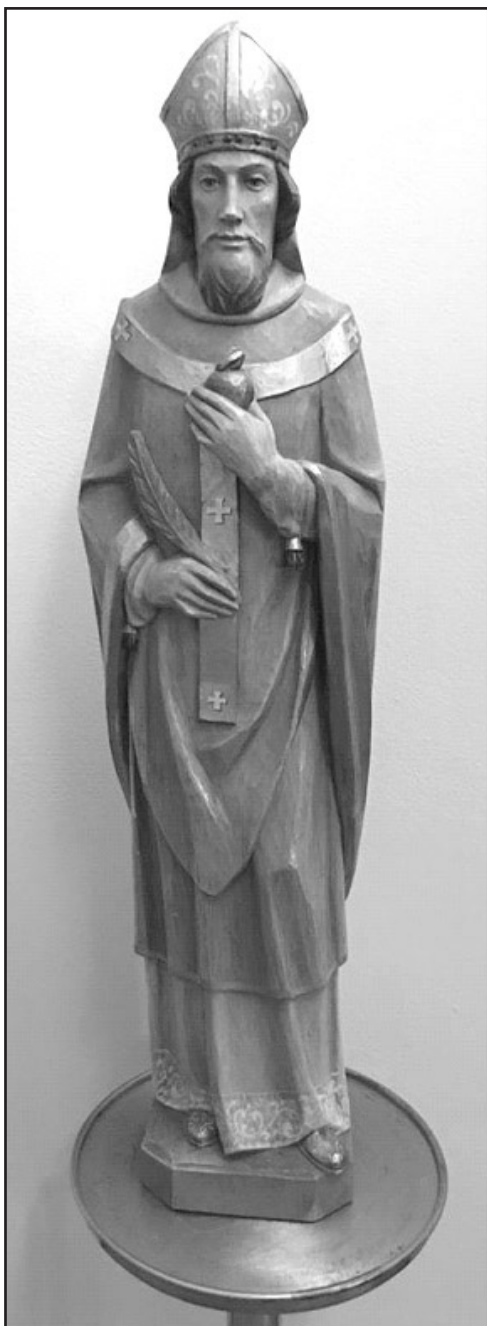

PASTOR'S DESK

August 28, 2022 - 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Rather, when you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you.” Luke 14:13-14

One of the main principles of living a stewardship lifestyle is to give without expecting anything in return. This is difficult for some to comprehend in our “consumerist” culture that we live in. This is even difficult for many parish communities that have become heavily dependent on parish fundraising events to support the mission and ministry of their local parish. Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it’s just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus’, renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

Posture during Sunday Liturgy:

Standing, the fundamental posture of the Christian assembly, deserves special attention. It is the posture of a resurrection people, the respectful posture of a community that recognizes the presence of the risen Lord, a sign of reverence for the Gospel, a sign of the common action of offering praise and thanksgiving expressed in the Eucharistic Prayer, and the posture of the family that lives in intimate communion with the all-holy God. It is also the posture of the action of offering and the posture of those who make covenant with their God. Finally, it is the posture of openness to Jesus Christ and to one another in the Eucharistic assembly.

Since the Second Vatican Council, standing has once again become the common posture for liturgy. Individual participants who are older, ill, disabled or tired, however, should understand that they are free to sit as necessary. Priests and pastors should communicate this to members of the assembly, especially older members and those who are ill.

Beyond the hour on Sunday:

I am still amazed at how we are getting so many visitors from other parishes, partaking of the “daily Eucharist”. There are not more than 10 regular parishioners of St Augustine parish coming, yet we can get up to 50 people for daily mass! Also please note, what does the future hold for “Refuge night” on the third Thursday of month? July 21st, we had only SIX folks come out for praise, worship and Adoration. I would like to offer a “*retreat format*” in September for parishioners, held over three evenings. A video series entitled: **Untold Blessing: three paths to holiness** by Bishop Barron. This is excellent and would benefit many parishioners in starting the pastoral year off. **Would there be interest?**
