"The favor of God was upon him"

A joyful mystery continues in the "presentation in the Temple" What is the significance of Simeon's encounter with the baby Jesus and his mother in the temple? Simeon was a just and devout man who was very much in tune with the Holy Spirit. He believed that the Lord would return to his temple and renew his chosen people. The Holy Spirit also revealed to him that the Messiah and King of Israel would also bring salvation to the Gentile nations. When Joseph and Mary presented the baby Jesus in the temple, Simeon immediately recognized this humble child of Bethlehem as the fulfillment of all the messianic prophecies, hopes, and prayers. Inspired by the Holy Spirit he prophesied that Jesus was to be "a revealing light to the Gentiles". The Holy Spirit reveals the presence of the Lord to those who are receptive and eager to receive him. Do you recognize the indwelling presence of the Lord with you?

In his catechesis, (weekday audience Wed. Dec. 13) Pope Francis responded to the question of why it is so important to go to Mass on Sundays and why it is not enough just to live a moral life, loving others. Sunday Mass is not simply an obligation, he said. "We Christians need to take part in Sunday Mass because only with the grace of Jesus, with his presence alive in us and among us, can we put into practice his commandment and, in this way, be his credible witnesses." We may do other things on the Lord's day and not partake of 'praise and thanks to God from whom all blessings flow; however in our journey of faith for a New year upon us, will that change. What opportunity is upon us?

"At a time of giving" it is interesting to note an article in the Catholic Register. Do you give regularly to the church? In lieu of money, an increasing number of Canadians are supporting charities on social media with hashtags, retweets and likes on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and similar sites. Sixty per cent of 18 to 24 year-olds and 58 per cent of 25 to 34 year-olds believe this activity is either "very" or "fairly" meaningful.

A big generational difference is that millennials trust that charities are spending their money wisely. Where 82 per cent of over 55 boomers agreed with the statement "Charities waste too much money on salaries, admin and fundraising," only 62 per cent of millennials would go along with that statement.
