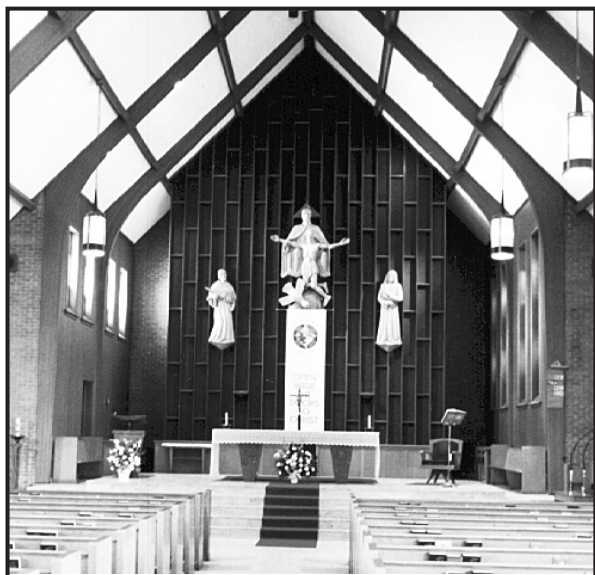

NORMS OF LENTEN OBSERVANCE

The liturgical season of Lent begins Wed., Feb. 10th. The following are guidelines of Lenten observance for the faithful in the Archdiocese of Ottawa.

- **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence from meat.
- **Fridays** are days of abstinence.

Fasting binds all persons who have completed their 18th birthday through those who have completed their 59th year, unless prevented by poor health. On days of fast, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's own needs. Eating between meals is not allowed although fluids may be taken.

Abstinence binds all persons who have completed their 14th birthday, unless prevented by poor health. In the Archdiocese of Ottawa, the consumption of meat is not allowed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent. The Archbishop mandates this observance for the spiritual well-being of the faithful.

Lent is a penitential season and, as such, religious practices such as daily Mass, the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Stations of the Cross, works of charity and justice, and acts of self-denial are highly encouraged.

MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS FOR THE 24TH WORLD DAY OF THE SICK 2016:

The 24th World Day of the Sick will be celebrated on **February 11th**, the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes. The Holy Father's Message is entitled: *Entrusting Oneself to the Merciful Jesus like Mary: "Do whatever he tells you"* (Jn 2:5). In his Message, Pope Francis invites all those who assist the sick and the suffering to draw their inspiration from Mary, the Mother of Mercy. "Let us entrust to the Virgin Mary our trials and tribulations, together with our joys and consolations. Let us beg her to turn her eyes of mercy towards us, especially in times of pain, and make us worthy of beholding, today and always, the merciful face of her Son Jesus," the Pope states.
