From the Pastor's Desk

JUNE 9, 2019 – THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

“But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth...” (John 16:13)

Jesus sent the Holy Spirit to help us know and live the truth. To prepare ourselves, we need to open our hearts to receive this gift before we can give it. Develop a daily prayer routine. Talk and listen to the Holy Spirit. This is best done in silence, when we can hear His response.

New Parish Pastoral Council: PPC has been formed following our deliberations on the New Evangelization Summit, Saturday June 1st, (here in boardroom). We are pleased to announce that Pauline McGrath will be chairperson, along with Joe Cousineau as vice-chair. We have gained two new youth reps. Sarah Cheung and Errol Coffi (both involved in 4:30 choir). Marg Heaslip, Joe Murphy and Michaela Digaicomo will continue for another year in this important council. Please note that this Council will be responsible to implement the themes of the New Evangelization and will also engage hospitality, good liturgy and outreach at Sunday mass. We will continue to foster pastoral works in pastoral care, faith formation and education.

Coordinator needed for Sacramental Preparation for Sacraments and also for the implementation of the Safe Environment policy program within the Parish. You can connect with the Diocesan website on a clearer overview of what the "safe environment policy" means. Basically, all parishes across our Diocese have to coordinate efforts within the parish to have police checks and procedures in place to protect the most vulnerable; i.e. youth and elderly. Any parishioner who has contact in ministry or service on behalf of the parish needs to have "clearance" through this new protocol; which would be obtained in an "on-line" process. The new coordinator in the parish would oversee this. All paid staff of the parish needs this new protocol which is the first phase. ALL pastors went through this new procedure last summer. You may note that your pastor has had "clearance"!

Returning to Florida: Fr. Stephen Olson was in residence here at St. Augustine, studying Canon Law, left Thursday June 6th. The day before he left, he learned that *the co-cathedral of the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee was damaged by fire Wednesday, with several of the chairs in the sanctuary set ablaze using an accelerant. The church's rector has said he suspects arson. According to the diocese, the cathedral and presiders' chairs were set on fire and were destroyed, while the flames charred the walls of the sanctuary and the building suffered smoke damage. No one was hurt and an investigation is underway, the diocese said. Let us offer Fr Stephen and his Diocese our thoughts and prayers. (Fr. Frank Scott)*
