

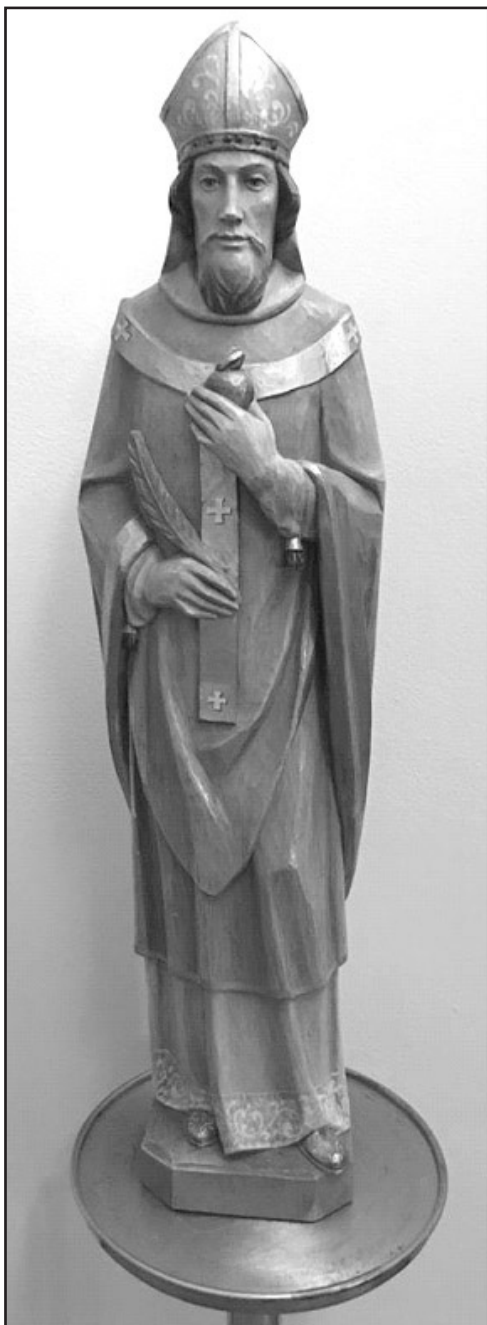

PASTOR'S DESK

June 21, 2020 - 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Would others know that you are Catholic by the way you act and speak? Do you share your Catholic faith with others? Do you defend your Catholic faith when the situation arises, or do you remain silent? Do you pray in public before meals? Pray for the strength and courage to be a joyful witness of our Catholic faith when the opportunity presents itself. Let us become the radiant light and bold witness that we are called to be!

Celebrating Holy Eucharist at St. Augustine's now looks quite different! In order to follow meet the guidelines and policies and required by the Province of Ontario and Health officials, a number of protocols need to be put into place. We had our first weekend Masses on June 14th with 35 to 40 people present at each mass. Below are some things to keep in mind when entering and participating at mass:

1. It is highly recommended that you wear a mask during mass. If you do not have a cloth mask of your own, disposable masks are available at entrances
2. Please follow the ushers instructions as to where to sit. It is most important that you arrive at least 5 to 10 minutes before mass to facilitate with this process.
3. Note there are only 8 pews available on each side of the main church. Gallery is open
4. At Communion time, a single line will be formed in the center aisle, with 2 meters (6 feet) between each person. Please respond to Eucharistic minister at the front pew and then proceed to receive the host in your hand only
5. There will be no processions, no offertory, no collection taken up ... basket will be provided at all entrances for your offering

New normal to celebrate mass:

Ontario's Phase 2 allows places of worship to open to 30% capacity.

SOME DIRECTIVES FROM THE ARCHDIOCESE

- Observe social distancing of 2 metres (6 feet) from everyone but members of your household. We encourage you to wear a face mask. Do not touch your neighbours at the Peace of Christ.
- Sanitize your hands upon entry and exit.
- Follow indicators on doors, floors, and pews.
- Refrain from using the washroom unless absolutely necessary.
- At Communion, say "Amen" to the Body of Christ at 2 metres from the priest or Eucharistic minister, approach with arms extended and one hand over the other palms up, receive and consume the Host, and withdraw, observing physical distancing with others.
- You may leave an offering in a basket at the back of the church after Mass.
- Continue to observe physical distancing after Mass.

PLEASE REFRAIN FROM ATTENDING CHURCH

IF ANY OF THESE APPLY TO YOU

- Any of the following symptoms: fever, coughing and wheezing, fatigue, loss of appetite, shortness of breath, excessive sputum, aching muscles, headaches, chills, confusion, runny nose, or shaking
- Contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Left the country or the province in the past 14 days
- Awaiting test results from your own COVID-19 test
