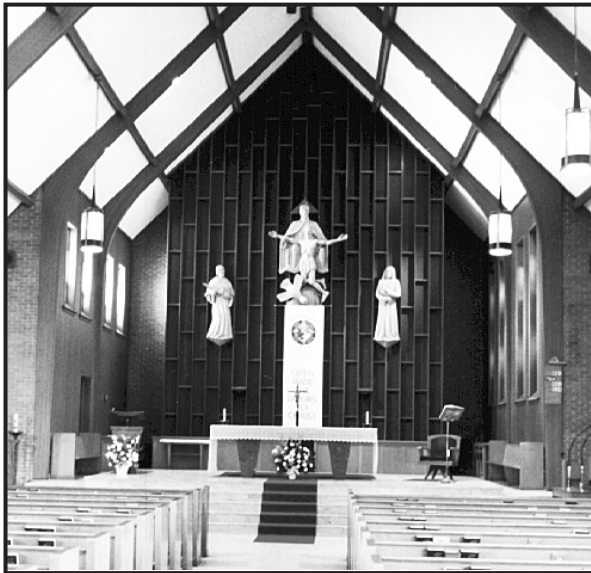

From the Pastor's Desk



Sunday (June 19):

"Who do you say that Jesus is?" Who is Jesus for you - and what difference does he make in your life? Many in Israel recognized Jesus as a mighty man of God, even comparing him with the greatest of the prophets. Peter, always quick to respond whenever Jesus spoke, professed that Jesus was truly the "Christ of God" - "the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:16). No mortal being could have revealed this to Peter, but only God. Through the "eyes of faith" Peter discovered who Jesus truly was. Peter recognized that Jesus was much more than a great teacher, prophet, and miracle worker. Who is Jesus for you? We clearly see/understand this in His Word and Eucharist.

Think of the four presence of Christ at liturgy 1) in the Assembly; 2) in His Word proclaimed; 3) Eucharistic species and in the tabernacle; 4) and in the Presider over the assembly and prayer.
