Sunday (June 26): **"No one who looks back"**
 A familiar saying on the farm! In fact I grew up on the farm and this saying is true for the farmer to the plow; there is no looking back. My father when he shared some thoughts to me while preparing for priesthood, in the seminary... "Frank, there is no looking back" I have often shared this same saying for a couple leaving the altar after their 'free' sharing of common rings and serious vows "for life"... "Sherry and John...don't look back" Jesus surprised his disciples by telling that they must not look back but keep their focus on the goal set for their lives - full happiness and union with God. A plowman who looked back caused his furrow to be crooked. Likewise, if we keep looking back to what we left behind, our path in following God will likely go off course and we'll miss what God has for us.
