

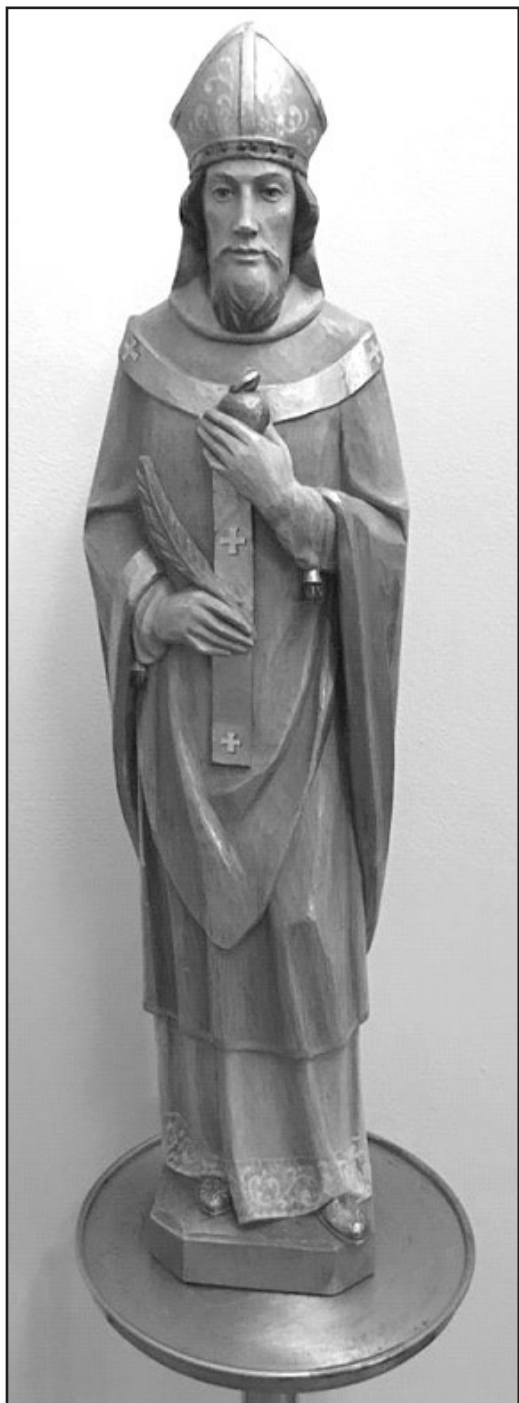

MARCH 11, 2018 – 4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

“God so loved the world that he gave us his only Son”

Do you know the healing power of Christ's redeeming love and victory which he won for us on the cross? Jesus points to a key prophetic sign which Moses performed in the wilderness right after the people of Israel were afflicted with poisonous serpents. Scripture tells us that many people died in the wilderness because of their sin of rebellion towards Moses and God. Through Moses' intervention, God showed mercy to the people and instructed Moses to "*make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and everyone who is bitten, when he sees it, shall live*"(Numbers 21:8). This miraculous sign was meant to foreshadow and point to the saving work which Jesus would perform to bring healing and salvation to the world.



Lent is a time to return to me with all your heart. **This coming Friday March 16th**, you have that opportunity to partake of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, starting with the devotions and adoration at 7 p.m. "Come let us adore Him". Priests will be available for confessions.
