

OUR MONTHLY REFUGE EVENING LITURGY WILL TAKE PLACE ON THURSDAY

MARCH 24TH, AT 7:00 P.M. ALL are welcome to attend! This evening will be the enrolment ceremony for the candidates who are celebrating the Easter Sacraments this year. It will commence with the Rite of Welcome for all candidates; as they commit themselves in readiness for the Sacraments. It will be followed with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and ends with Benediction. Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."

<u>Please note</u>: Our monthly Refuge evening has moved from the third Friday of the month to the third Thursday of the month.

During his Angelus on Sunday, March 13th, the day of the ninth anniversary of his election as Bishop of Rome, the Pope said, "In the name of God, I ask you: stop this massacre!" During his appeal, the Pope recalled the victims of Mariupol, as well as the "barbarity of the killing of children, innocents and unarmed civilians". He also asked for an end to what he unequivocally called "an unacceptable armed aggression" before it "reduces cities to cemeteries" and he expressed his gratitude for the welcome given to the many refugees before, finally, asking everyone to increase moments of prayer for peace.
