

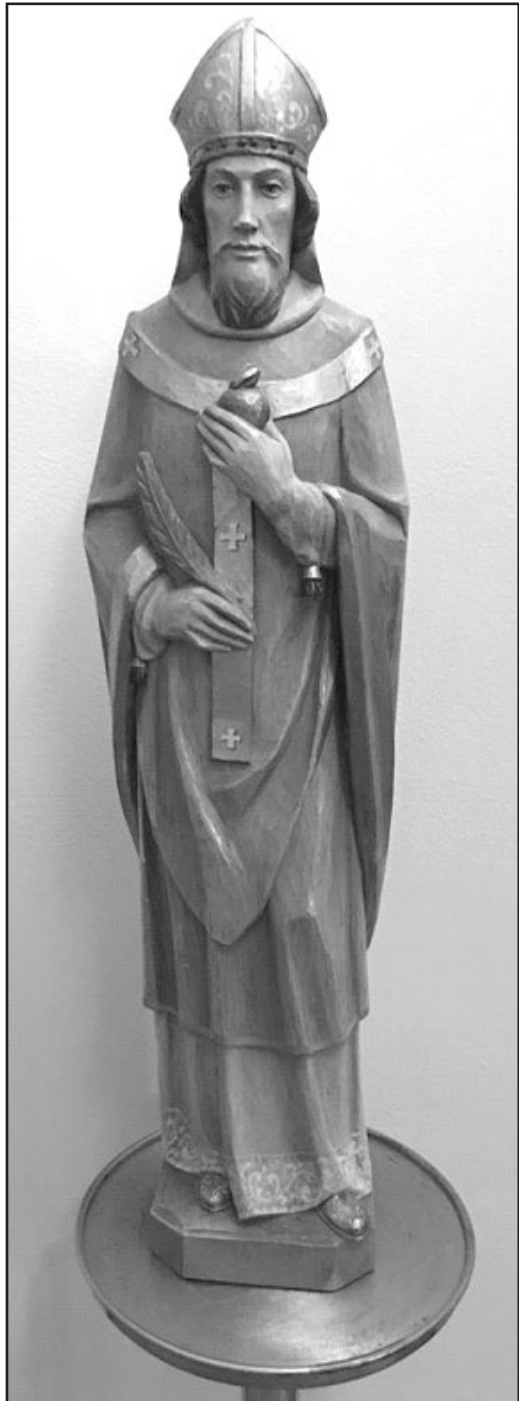

Alexandria-Cornwall (18-04-27)

It was announced at the Vatican this morning (April 27), that Pope Francis has united the Diocese of Alexandria--Cornwall and the Archdiocese of Ottawa ‘in the person of the bishop’ [*in persona episcopi*]. Archbishop Prendergast is no longer the Apostolic Administrator of the Diocese of Alexandria-Cornwall but now its Bishop. Moreover, a second Auxiliary Bishop will be appointed at a later date to assist Archbishop Prendergast specifically for the territory of Alexandria -Cornwall. (taken from Archdiocesan website).
