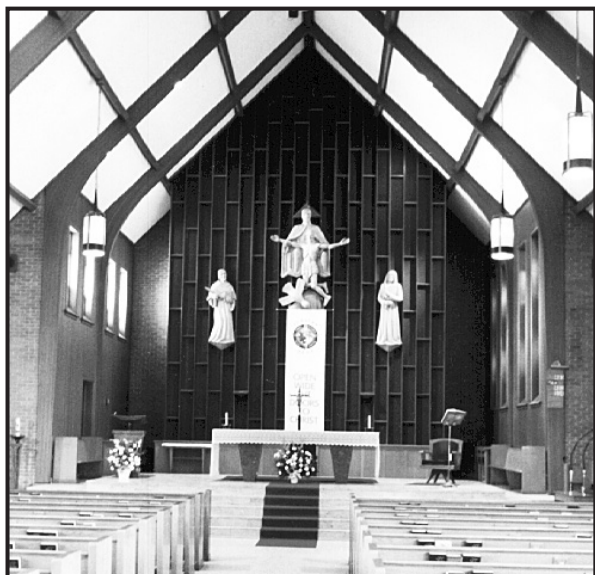

From the Pastor's Desk

Sixth Sunday of Easter (C), May 1, 2016
“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you” (Jn 14:27)

When discussing questions of tradition and change in the church, whether at the parish level or that of the universal church, “peace” is not the first word that jumps to mind. The tensions in the life of the church today, though, mirror those at the time of the Apostles. What must bind the church together throughout its differences is the understanding that the Holy Spirit is present among the disciples of Jesus. Christ connects the giving of the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, to the giving of his peace (*eirēnē*) to the disciples. But if the giving of the Holy Spirit to the church is the promise of peace, what kind of peace does Christ give? Think about Christ’s promise of peace. What does this promise mean to you in the church? What does peace mean to you personally? How does the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete, guide you as you seek peace in your life and in the church?

It has seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us to impose on you no further burden than what is essential.

2nd Reading: Revelation 21.10-14, 22-23

The Holy Spirit will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you.
