

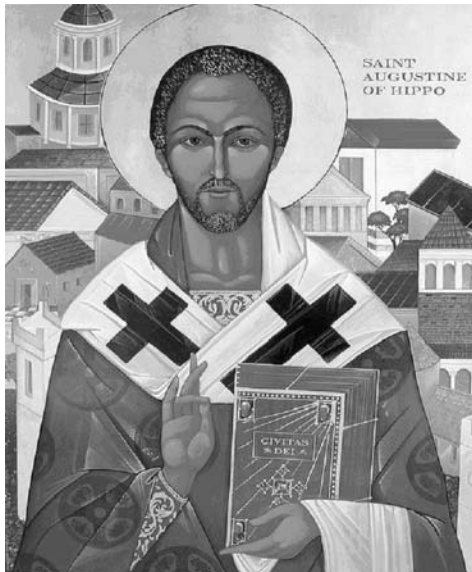

"Take heed that you are not led astray"

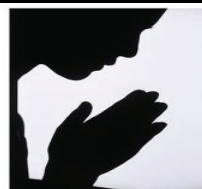
