

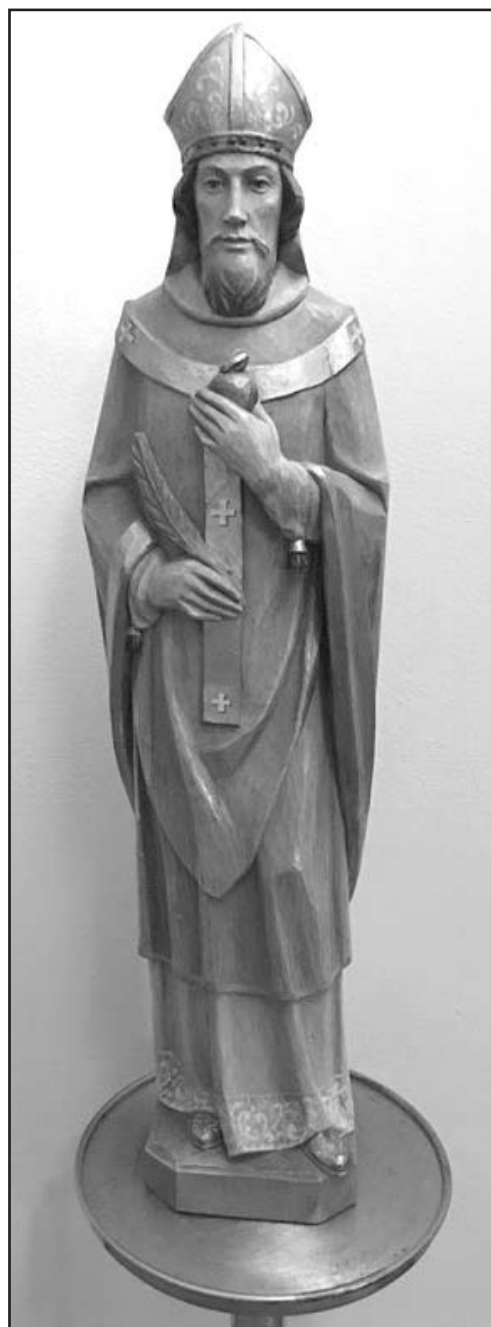

Archbishop Prendergast announced that Dec. 8th will be the time for the new Archbishop Most Rev. Marcel Dampousse to begin his ministry as the NEW Archbishop of Ottawa. We prayerfully wish him well in the transition and challenges ahead for our Diocese. In mid-December the Diocesan Centre on Kilborn will be closed and vacated, making way for the new location across the street at St Thomas d'Aquin Church. The church will be retrofitted to accommodate Pastoral and Temporal offices, Chancery and Tribunal, and office for the new Archbishop.
