NOV. 19TH – 33RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

Scripture: Matthew 25:14-30 The parable of the talents

Do you seek to serve God with the gifts, talents, and graces he has given to you?

Why did Jesus tell this story and what can it teach us? Most importantly it tells us something about how God deals with us, his disciples and servants. The parable speaks first of the Master's trust in his servants. While he goes away he leaves them with his money to use as they think best. While there were no strings attached, this was obviously a test to see if the Master's workers would be industrious and reliable in their use of the money entrusted to them. The master rewards those who are industrious and faithful and he punishes those who sit by idly and who do nothing with his money.

What is our mission was a phrase brought to the Parish Pastoral Council meeting Nov. 2nd. As we ponder financial challenges here in the parish we all need to take a serious look at the purpose of our parish mission and parish life! There are many pastoral areas in promoting the vision for the New Evangelization; bringing the Gospel to parishioners, visitors, enquirers who come to our church. Every year people bring home bulletins from Florida or other places and show me how the collections are very generous! \$20/30 per week is about the average donation per person, in the USA or from a fishing village in PEI ... where the collection could be over 5K. (This is nothing but generous). Our collections cover about 175 envelopes weekly average, out of 300 for distribution. You will notice in last week's bulletin (Nov.5) the collections to date are 50K below budget set a year ago at over 190K (for 2017). Would you like to increase your weekly offering; to help us offset projected costs, keeping our investment to gain interest?

<u>Tithing is a spiritual action</u>. In a materialistic age, it reminds us that Jesus is Lord of our lives. But it is also a spiritual offering to God. There is a reason that the collection is carried up to the altar as part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and offered up with the bread and wine. Spiritually we should offer ourselves up -- our time, talent and treasure -- during the offertory of each Mass. It has been a long tradition to give 10% of weekly earnings to your church community!

Special mass being offered on Thursday Jan. 4th, at 7:00 p.m., here in the church.

This mass is offered for all those who have died in 2017. The Parish pastoral council is facilitating invitations and assistance for this evening's memorial mass. All families in the parish who still mourn the loss of a loved is especially remembered in this Holy season of Christmas.
