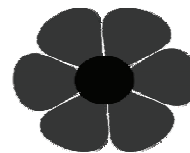

Climate change is an issue of justice! The most poor and vulnerable in the Global South suffer most from the impacts of climate change, yet they contribute the least to the carbon emissions that are warming the planet. In his encyclical *Laudato Si*, Pope Francis reminds us of our responsibility to act: “*The pace of consumption, waste and environmental change has so stretched the planet’s capacity that our contemporary lifestyle, unsustainable as it is, can only precipitate catastrophes, such as those which even now periodically occur in different areas of the world. The effects of this imbalance can only be reduced by our decisive action, here and now.*” **Development and Peace’s** new campaign asks us to take action on climate change. In December, world leaders will meet in Paris at the United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP21) to negotiate a binding and universal agreement on the world’s climate. Join other parishioners in signing the **Development and Peace’s** Action Card asking the Prime Minister to make Canada a climate leader by negotiating and signing the international binding agreement at COP21 setting targets to keep the rise in global temperature below 2°C, and to be a leader in achieving those targets.
